How do you know God is real? We have evidence and clues, but ultimately there is some level of faith needed for us to know how real God really is. Why is there doubt? Why is it hard for us? In this final message of our series, Asking for A Friend, Pastor Ryan shows us that God has made Himself known and knowable.

READ Romans 1:20-23. What are some of the *invisible qualities* that God has revealed Himself?

BIG IDEA: God has made Himself known and knowable.

Creation: READ Psalm 19:1-4. What are the ways you have experienced God through nature, beauty, and creation?

Conscience: READ Romans 2:14-15. If you traveled around the world, you would find evidence in every society and culture of God's moral law. We all have a sense of morality, of right and wrong. Where does that come from in your life?

Christian Experiences: What are the experiences that remind you that God is real and present in your life? To put it another way, if someone asked you how God is real, what would you say?

Jesus Christ: READ Romans 6:23, John 1:7 and Corinthians 5:17. God wants to make Himself known by you, and knowable through his Son Jesus Christ. He wants you to know that He is real, and to be in a relationship with you.
