3. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged or confused you?
4. What do you think it means to "live in the tension of the teaching and the reaching of Jesus?"
5. What is God teaching YOU lately?
6. Who is someone in your life that you sometimes think is "unreachable," and why? What does this passage teach you, and how does it instill hope?
7. Have you ever been surprised to learn about someone's heart? Explain.
8. Do you have any experience with expressing acceptance...and experiencing pushback? Share your story.
9. Share your thoughts on this statement: "Your dinner table is perhaps your most effective tool for reaching people."
10. Share about a time when you got to play a role in bringing someone to Jesus. What happened in their life, and in yours?
