INTRODUCTIONS

3. **READ Romans 15:13**

- b. What does this passage mean to you?
- c. Is it difficult to trust God? How can the power of the Holy Spirit help?

4. **READ Mark 10:17-27**

- a. What does this young man have? What does he lack?
- b. Why did Jesus tell him to sell all of his possessions?
- c. What is Jesus trying to tell us in these passages?

Spend time this week looking at the areas of your life that you are placing ABOVE JESUS as your source of joy. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you trust God in these areas as you look to Jesus to be your greatest source of Joy!
