



FOR THE VALLEY College Scholarship Spring 2022

We here at Community Presbyterian Church believe the students of our valley are the future of our community. We are **FOR** our students. We are thrilled to be able to invest in the future of San Ramon Valley's students by offering a \$3,000 college scholarship to 4 senior students in the San Ramon Valley Unified School District.

Community Presbyterian Church started a community initiative in January of 2019 called **For the Valley**. We believe that being for others can change the world. As a High School Senior you have a voice, a creative spirit and the potential to bring positive change to our world. We want to support that creativity and encourage you to invest your time and talents to make our world a better place to live.

THE APPLICATION

Your submission should be titled "How Being FOR Others Can Change the World". In your project submission you should answer the question how you have been FOR others in your school, community or the world at large and clearly communicate what change has come about as the result of your actions.

Your submission may be in the form of a song, photo, painting, dance, drawing, video, monologue, essay, poem or service project incorporating any or several of these elements. If you choose to perform a service project, it must be an original idea, not an execution of a pre-existing or "turn-key" project. WE want to see your creativity and vision for a need and a way to respond.



EVALUATION:

All submissions will be evaluated on the following 5 criteria:

- Item 1** - How well does the submitted form of expression convey that the student has been FOR a group or individuals
 - Item 2** - Is the recipient group(s) or individual(s) identified in the submission and was a need identified that the student was trying to fill
 - Item 3** - Does the submitted form of expression clearly identify how being FOR others could change the world in a positive way
 - Item 4** - Is the students expression of FOR something that could be repeated by others if modeled by the student in the community
 - Item 5** - Is this students effort and their form of expression creative and thoughtful
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THE DETAILS:

Whether you are going to a 2 or 4 year college, we want to be a part of your future. The winning applicants will receive a letter stating that FOR the Valley will be giving them a \$3,000 scholarship toward their college tuition.

The submission must include the below form and signed waiver. For the Valley will be sharing all submissions throughout social media, etc. as part of FOR the Valley's campaign to show how being for others can change the world.

The winning applicants will send in his/her tuition bill to FOR the Valley who will pay the school directly in the Fall of 2022. If the winning applicant is choosing to go to a 2 year college, they can choose for the scholarship to pay for tuition to the 2 year college over time or for the scholarship to be held for when they transfer to a 4 year college.

If the student that is awarded the scholarship changes his/her mind and does not attend a 2 or 4 year college program, they will not be awarded the scholarship. Students that have a parent that is employed at CPC will not be considered for this scholarship.

Submit the following form and waiver with your submission no later than **midnight on April 17, 2022** to scholarship@cpcdanville.org.

The FOR Scholarship team will review all the submissions and contact every applicant no later than May 2, 2022.



ENTRY APPLICATION

Your submission must show how YOU have been FOR others and how doing that can make a difference to another person. The submission can be in any of the following forms of expression: a song, a photo, a painting, a dance, a drawing, a video, a monologue, an essay or a poem.
