INTRODUCTION

As we continue to look at the Gospel of John, we see that Jesus is introducing Himself. *"I am the light of the world."*

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. **READ John 8:58.**
 - a. What do you think when He says "before Abraham was, I am."
2. **READ John 1:1-5**
 - a. How do these scriptures confirm what Jesus stated?
 - b. Looking at verse 5, what promise do you see?
3. **READ John 8:12**
 - a. What is the promise in this verse?
 - b. Discuss as a group what these two promises mean to His followers.
4. **READ John 9: 1-7.**
 - a. Why do you think the disciples asked Jesus about who sinned?
5. **READ John 9: 8-23.**
 - a. Even his neighbors didn't recognize the blind man! Do you know anyone that has had their life changed so dramatically by God that you no longer recognize them?
6. **WE ENJOY NEW WONDER**
 - a. **READ John 9: 24-25.** I WAS BLIND, BUT NOW I SEE! Does statement apply to YOUR STORY? Briefly share with the group.
7. **WE FOCUS ON BEHOLDING NOT BEHAVING**
 - a. How will our lives change if we focus on BEHOLDING instead of BEHAVING?
8. **WE EXPERIENCE A NEW PERSPECTIVE**
 - a. What are some of the areas of your life that need a new perspective?

CHALLENGE

We see differently when we TRUST and FOLLOW Jesus. This week spend time looking for the WONDERS of God. Remind yourself to focus on BEHOLDING the glory of Jesus as He continues to change your perspective on life.
