INTRODUCTION

It's easy to be blind to the people or the world around you. We pass by blooming flowers in the spring, kids laughing in the park, and beautiful sunsets. Sometimes it's hard to see what God wants us to see, how He wants to change us, or the action He wants us to take...as part of the miracle we want to see Him do in our life.

7. Sometimes God wants to grow something deeper in us that only comes through a process of waiting, obeying and being faithful. Have you ever found yourself in a period of waiting on God? If so, how did you grow in that time of waiting?

8. What are 1-2 ways you can begin to apply what you learned in the message this week?
