“Jesus, a Dead Girl and a Sick Woman”

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What are YOUR first memories of TV shows growing up?
2. The big idea was simple: **If you read and apply God’s Word, you’ll experience God’s power.** How often do you read and apply God’s Word? What are some benefits to this habit? Have you ever experienced the power of God in your life (ie. something that made you think, “That’s incredible!”)? Explain.
3. **Read Mark 5:21-28.** Why were the actions of Jairus and the bleeding woman bold in that culture, and what were their motives and beliefs?
4. When was the last time you did, said or prayed for something BOLD? Then what happened? What is one BOLD step God is nudging you to take?
5. **Read Mark 5:29-34.** Here Jesus was interruptible. In our current culture, why is living an interruptible life challenging?
6. Are you living an interruptible life? How do you know?
7. **Read Mark 5:35-40.** Here we see Jesus (and Jairus) being patient—so much that people laugh at Jesus. How patient are you with Jesus? With others?
8. **Read Mark 5:40-43.** As you follow Jesus, some ways to apply God’s Word are being BOLD, INTERRUPTIBLE, and PATIENT. In the entire passage today, what are some ways people experience God’s power? Why do you think reading and applying God’s Word leads to experiencing God’s power?
9. As a result of your boldness, being interruptible, or being patient...where have you experienced God’s incredible POWER in the past? Where are you hoping to experience God’s POWER in the future? (These can become the prayer requests for your group this week.)

CHALLENGE

Make time every day this week (even 5-10 minutes) to read God’s Word, pray, and try to apply God’s Word to your life.

PRAYER

Share prayer requests and pray for one another. Pray that you would read and apply God’s Word, and experience His power in ways that lead you to say, “That’s incredible!”
