READ Ephesians 6:18-20

Discuss each phrase of this passage, what Scott said and additional thoughts of your own..

Pray in the Spirit – Scott had one interpretation, what else can this mean?

On all occasions – what did Scott suggest? What others come to mind? When is it hard to do?

With all kinds of prayer and requests – was the comparison to a foreign language helpful? The cursing psalms? Which examples of non-traditional prayer are you planning to try?

With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying – what helps you remember to pray? Do you use ACTS, or some other structure for prayer?

For all God's people –who is on your prayer list? Are there some people or groups you will never meet included? How can you keep your ongoing prayer list fresh?

Pray also for me – (reread 6:19-20) Paul asked for prayer for the words and the courage to declare the gospel fearlessly despite his chains. Where is God asking you to do this? How can we pray specifically for you to act on this call? May we hold you accountable?
