

"Mighty God" December 14 –15, 2019 Pastor Tyler Scott

INTRODUCTION

Today we continue to look closely at the prophet Isaiah's four names for the child that will be *born to us* and *given to us*. We discovered in the first week that Jesus is our exceptional and Wonderful Counselor. And last week we began to TRUST and SEE that Jesus is our timeless Everlasting Father. Now we will look at why we should TRUST Jesus as MIGHTY GOD.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Today we learned the Greek translation of trust (pisteuo) to mean; *confidence to put your weight on*. And MIGHTY GOD in Hebrew (El gibbor) means; *Hero/Mighty One/Champion*. Discuss what it means to you to put the weight of your life on your MIGHTY GOD?
- 2. **PROVE -** In one day we can we see how Jesus PROVES to us that he has POWER over 4 realms.
- 3. **Read Mark 4:35-41.** How does Jesus show He has the POWER over the NATURAL realm?
- 4. **Read Mark 5:1-20.** How does Jesus show He has the POWER over the SPIRITUAL realm?
- 5. **Read Mark 5:21-42.** How does Jesus show He has the POWER over the PHYSICAL realm with the woman with the issue of blood? How does Jesus show He has the POWER over the ETERNAL realm with Jairus.
- 6. We all struggle at times with our fears of natural disasters, or evil spirits, or sickness or maybe even death. How can we look at these fears with a different perspective as a Christian?
- 7. **PERSONALIZE** Sometimes it is difficult for us to really know that we can TRUST God. **Read Phil 2:13 and Phil 1:6**. Discuss how we can trust God.
- 8. Read Zephaniah 3:17. In this powerful scripture we find that God is
 - WITH US
 - He FIGHTS FOR US
 - He DELIGHTS IN US
 - He LOVES US
 - He REJOICES OVER US.

Discuss these attributes of God as they apply to YOU personally.

Today we are reminded that we should TRUST Jesus as our MIGHTY GOD. This week, make it a point to remind yourself every day that Jesus is with you and is fighting for you! Jesus loves you, rejoices over you and delights in you! Next week we will look at our PRINCE OF PEACE!
