We also heard one of the most profound and timely messages delivered by Miles McPherson, pastor of the Rock Church in San Diego and author of *The Third Option: Hope for a Racially Divided Nation*. DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

What did you learn about other ethnicities or races from the stories that you just heard?

- 1. Read 2 Chronicles 7:14-15
 - a. Where do we see the hope in this passage?
- 2. Read Joshua 5:13-15
 - a. Joshua asked "Are you for us or for our enemies?" How did the commander of the army answer?
- 3. 1 Corinthians 1:10 and 1 Corinthians 12:12-27
 - a. What does the Bible say about division?
 - b. How can these passages be applied to today?

Pastor Miles Gave Us Some ACTION ITEMS. Discuss as a group.

- Acknowledge that you have Blind Spots, that you do not know the whole story.
 a. What does it mean to be a humble learner?
- 2. Rename Those People as Your "Brothers" / "Sisters" / "Neighbor".
 - a. Read Matthew 22:36-39. Who is our neighbor?
- 3. Acknowledge your "Brother's" / "Sister's" COLOR. Then Celebrate it!
- 4. View every "conversation" as a race "conversation."
 - a. Read James 1:19. How does this passage apply?
- 5. Give your heart to those who are "not like you."
 - a. Read John 15:13
