



## STUDENT WEEKEND JUNE 13 - 14, 2020 // CPC Students

### INTRODUCTION

This weekend we had the privilege of hearing four of our graduating High School Seniors share their testimonies of how God has been at work in their lives. When Christians talk about sharing their testimony, they're simply talking about sharing ways they have personally experienced God's presence and activity in their lives. Most of us might be hesitant to share personally about matters of our faith; but this kind of sharing can play a valuable role in encouraging others in their faith.

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

#### THE VALUE OF TESTIMONY

If someone asked you to share about how God has been at work in your life, what would be one or two highlights you would want to mention?

##### 1) READ Romans 1:11-12

- a) Paul's words to the believers in Rome sounds especially appropriate for us as we long to see each other! What was Paul's motivation for wanting to see these believers in Rome?
- b) How is sharing your "testimony" like giving a spiritual gift to someone else?
- c) Our nation is in a time of pain and struggle right now. How do you think God wants this to add to our testimonies in the future?

#### MAINTAINING YOUR FAITH

##### 2) READ 1 John 5:14-15

- a) Charlie shared that prayer played a huge role in his faith journey. When you read this passage, do you have this same confidence in prayer? How can we strive to gain that confidence?
- b) What are ways you try to maintain your faith in a world that seems to continually pull us away from Jesus?

#### WHEN GOD SAYS NO

##### 3) READ Romans 8:28

- a) When we experience disappointment, struggle, or loss like Tori, we often are left feeling like God has abandoned us in our circumstances. What does this important verse tell about those situations?
- b) When have you experienced God saying "No" to an important request and how did that affect your faith in Him?

## BEING A GODLY INFLUENCE FOR OTHERS

### 4) READ 1 Timothy 4:12

- a) It's encouraging to see how students, like Blake, are living out this verse. Although, we never outgrow the instructions in this verse. How has God used you to set an example or help someone else to get to know Jesus better?

## THE VALUE OF A CHURCH FAMILY

### 5) READ Ephesians 2:22

- a) This passage makes it clear that God intends to build us together in living connections to make us His church. How can more of us grow to feel as comfortable and connected with our church family as Grace expressed?

## CHALLENGE

Psalm 145:4 says, "One generation commends your works to another; they tell of your mighty acts." This week, as we heard from a younger generation of disciples, let's look to those who are older and younger than us and strive to live out those words with others.
