INTRODUCTION:

Through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, we are FREE! So why is it that we are still living in a life of bondage and performance-based faith? Today we will learn what we can do to live free in Christ.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

WE ARE SET FREE **BY** CHRIST. WE MUST LIVE FREE **IN** CHRIST.

1) READ Galatians 5:1

- a) What freedom is Paul talking about?
- b) Tyler talks about the difference between "being free" and "living free". In what areas of your life do you struggle to live free in Christ?
- 2) READ Galatians 1:4, Galatians 2:20, Galatians 3:13 and Galatians 4:4-7.
 - a) What do each of these passages tell us?
 - b) Look again at Galatians 5:1. What are we set free from?
- WAYS YOU CAN LIVE FREE IN CHRIST.

3) STOP TRYING TO BE PERFECT. READ Galatians 5:2-4

- a) Why do you think Paul was being so firm with them?
- b) What is the difference in being justified by the law, and freedom in Christ?
- c) How does their behavior indicate their attempt at being perfect?

4) WAIT FAITHFULLY. READ Galatians 5:5

- a) This passage reminds us that through the Spirit we don't have to work it out ourselves, we can wait for the Holy Spirit to do His work.
- b) What are you waiting for the Holy Spirit to do in you?

5) LOVE GENEROUSLY. READ Galatians 5:6

- a) What is the only thing that counts?
- b) What are some ways we can LOVE GENEROUSLY?

6) OBEY JOYFULLY. READ Galatians 5:7

a) Our obedience is not SO THAT we will be accepted. Our obedience is BECAUSE we are accepted. What are some things that keep us from obeying joyfully?

COMMIT TO MEMORY

It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery. Galatians 5:1
